Church. Fr Kofler was a Mill Hill Missionary who was also an accredited
psychotherapist, group psychotherapist,

supervisor and trainer. He was ordained in 1959. In 1968 he took up further studies in sociology, psychology and pastoral theology and was in charge of formation at a minor seminary. In 1978 Fr. Kofler joined the staff of the Missionary Institute London as a lecturer. In 1980 he was elected president and continued to lecture and counsel till July 1985. He also gave lectures for London University Extra Mural Departments. He saw the need to train leaders for the Church. 

It is run by the Carmelite Fathers O.Carm.
The Institute of St. Anselm is situated at one side of the campus, just inside the main gate. All rooms are ensuite. There is a large simple garden with beautiful trees providing a quiet natural setting. The food is excellent Italian food.

It is a 20/25 minutes walk to the nearest train station, Acqua Acetosa. From here the train to Roma Termini takes just 20 minutes. There are more trains from Ciampino. To Ciampino Airport it is a ten minutes drive. We rarely hear the planes!



Programme Contents

The content of the programmes encourages reflection on your relationship with God, with others and with yourselves. As a participant you will be guided in the process of getting to know yourself better through a deeper understanding of your emotional life, your spiritual life and your general patterns of behaviour.

In one-to one, growth facilitation practice and participation in growth groups you will develop your listening skills and improve your relating skills. You will be helped to work towards a greater simplicity of life and a readiness to forgive and be reconciled with others, recognizing God's infinite mercy with our weaknesses.

You will learn to use what happens to you, including the differences found in others, as a gift from God and an opportunity to develop your process of personal growth and integration. As you leave the Institute of St Anselm, with many tools, you will have the means to help you to 'live in an on-going process' for the rest of your life.
